As a result of COVID-19 and in consideration of the health and safety of all staff and residents, Quinte Waste Solutions will be postponing operations at the Household Hazardous Waste Depot located at 75 Wallbridge Crescent, Belleville, until further notice. This also includes the cancellation of all Mobile Events planned for May:

As well, our Electronic Waste Program at our Material Recovery Facility (270 West Street, Trenton) remains closed to the public. We ask that all hazardous and electronic waste be held onto until we regain normal operations.
